Nomination & Application Procedures

Our Exchange application process includes 2 phases:

- 1. **NOMINATION** by the partner school or university
 The student's nominations must be sent by e-mail to
 international@ensci.com including all the following details:
 - Student's name and surname
 - Student's email address
 - Major field of study: Product design, Service Design, Space-Interior Design, Interaction design, Textile Design...
 - Exchange period: 1st semester, 2nd semester
 - Industrial Design or Textile Design
 - French & English Language knowledge:
 Elementary, Intermediate, Advanced, No knowledge or A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2 according to the CEFR.

2. **APPLICATION** by sending documents **in PDF format** to international@ensci.com

- Portfolio or website
- Letter of motivation
- CV
- Copy of passport
- Academic transcripts (+ translation in English)
- Certificate of proficiency in French and if needed, in English: letters from the sending institution are accepted. Recommended (but not compulsory) level in French: A2; minimum level in English: B2.
- A nice photograph (ID type)
- Year and country of your high school degree
- A Video Interview will also be conducted after reviewing the elements mentioned above.

All applications are reviewed as part of the admissions process. Due to the small size of our school we offer a limited number of places for exchange students, so please be aware that **students are not guaranteed a study place**. We strongly recommend that students consider alternatives.

In Textile Design, there are maximum 2 places per semester. The first semester allows learning in depth weaving and knitting. The second semester is dedicated to projects.



Exchange Duration

6 months / 1 semester

Language requirements

Classes are mainly conducted in French. However, we give some classes and seminars in English and some major project studio are English-speaking or at least English-Firendly.

Level advised in French: A2

Level required in English: minimum B2

Study Programme

We offer an interdisciplinary design approach with individualised programming and project-based learning. Interdisciplinary approach means our programme in Industrial Creation is not structured in separate "majors" or tracks.

Our Textile Design programme is separate from Industrial Creation.

One semester's programme for each student consists of the following:

- 1 major project atelier (15 ECTS)
- 1 minor project studio (3 ECTS)
- 2 or 3 "intensive" weeks (3 ECTS each)
- 1 or 2 weekly classes (3 ECTS each)

Since the major project ateliers are often projects with industry partners, they differ each semester. It is therefore rarely possible to inform students in advance of the fields covered in upcoming semesters and / or the specific skills the project will focus on.

Learning agreements should be started as follows:

ECOLE NATIONALE SUPERIEURE DE CREATION INDUSTRIELLE (all in capital)

01 Atelier de Projet: 15 ECTS02 Creative Studio: 3 ECTS03 Intensives (2): 6 ECTS04 Weekly classes (2): 6 ECTS

They are subject to modifications in respect of Erasmus+ charters.

End of June / beginning of July for Semester 1, early January we present the courses for Semester 2.



Before the end of the semester, we organise individual tutoring sessions for exchange students to determine the programme that would best match, diversify, or enhance their profile and practice.

Please note that the enrolment is also subject to:

- the number of places available in the classes, and
- the English and French language skills of the student.

The pedagogical program of ongoing semester is available in French for reference upon request by email.

The pedagogical program of the following semester is sent to the students in French and English, 4-6 weeks before the integration week.

Credit System/Grades

30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) are required to validate the semester.

Grading system: from A (highest) to C (weak pass); D = more work required; E = Fail

Grades will be sent to the partner institution at the end of each semester.

VISA, Accomodation and Insurance

hce ENSCI – Les Ateliers provides by mail and if needed, by post, a letter stating the Student Exchange Agreement for any purpose such as VISA, Scholarships, Accommodation and Insurance, Banking, Transportation Pass, etc.

ENSCI – Les Ateliers does not provide on or off campus accommodation but can provide guidance to students.

ENSCI – Les Ateliers takes no responsibility for any accident that might occur on the premises during the exchange period. To cover this risk, the student is required to provide proof of an insurance policy including third party coverage (liability insurance).

NON-EU students must have a health insurance covering their stay in France and must subscribe to the French national health insurance ("Sécurité Sociale") for free. https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/

EU Students must have a European Health Insurance Card.

FEES & COSTS

No fees are due for exchange programs, provided inter institutional agreements are signed.



However, Safety gear is <u>mandatory</u> in the metal, wood and mock-up, paint workshops for health reasons.

You can bring your own Safety gear, or you can buy one upon your arrival at ENSCI for a cost beyond 110€. The safety gear includes 3M Mask (dust and gas), 1 set of mask cartridges, Ear protection, gloves, glasses.

Please bring your own safety gear if you have one.

An ENSCI jacket is sold for 40 €, if required by the student.
